If you complete an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree, 60 credits are guaranteed to transfer to a Colorado public four-year school, once you are accepted for admission. Please note that some majors at the four-year school require specific courses that must be completed as part of the A.A or A.S degree. Additional notes regarding transfer:

Only courses completed with a "C" or higher will be eligible to transfer.
