To be put on the wait list the following need to be completed:

Documentation of college level course work in English, Math, Reading.
 This is done by ACT/SAT scores, accuplacer scores or college level course work.

Prerequisite Requirements:

Must be completed with a grade of "C" or better
 A cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required for all prerequisites except for pathophysiology, math and nutrition.
 Science prerequisites are valid for 7 years from time of completion to the start of the Nursing Program

- Negative Drug Screen
- Satisfactory Health statement/Immunization record
