

International and Non-US Citizen Student Admission

Thank you for inquiring about attending Northeastern Junior College. An I-20 form, required by INS to obtain an international student visa, will be issued when documents 1-6 are received on record and evaluated as acceptable. Admission of international and non-US students will be considered under the following guidelines. Students attending with special visitation groups will be admitted under separate admission guidelines.

The following must be provided:

- 1. **Application for admission** to Northeastern Junior College, with valid signatures, is required. The application must indicate which semester the student will begin.
- 2. Copy of Passport or National Identification Card
- 3. **Official and complete transcripts** of all previous secondary and collegiate academic work with certified English translations, (if needed).
- 4. **Proof of English proficiency** if the student's native language is other than English, he/she must provide <u>one</u> of the following:
 - a) Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) showing a minimum score of 475 (paper based) or 150 (computer based) or 52 (internet based)

- b) Michigan Test of English Language Proficiency showing a minimum score of 75.
- c) Recommendations from the English Language School with completion of Level 109.
- d) Completion of Level 5 advanced at an Intensive English Language Center.
- e) Graduation from an American high school after attending for at least two years.
- f) A student who has taken the STEP examination in Japan and holds at least a LEVEL II evaluation.
- g) Special admission wavier approved by the College President.
- 5. **Statement of financial support** for a particular program of study at Northeastern Junior College. Federal financial aid and scholarships are currently not available for international and non-US citizen students.
- 6. Record of immunizations

- 7. A \$500 non-refundable deposit to go toward tuition and fees once the student enrolls in classes. This deposit is required prior any processing of an international student application for students residing outside the US.
- 8. **Proof of medical insurance** must be provided or purchased prior to registering for classes. All non-US citizen students are required to have medical insurance for the duration of time they are enrolled in courses.
- 9. **Payment** of the remaining tuition and fees is due at registration or establish a payment plan using FACTS. Failure to comply will result in withdrawal of their U.S. Immigration Form 20 (I-20).

Note: International and non-US citizen students may be admitted for one (1) semester as a "Special Student" with approval of Designated School Official; after one (1) semester, all regular admission standards must be met.
