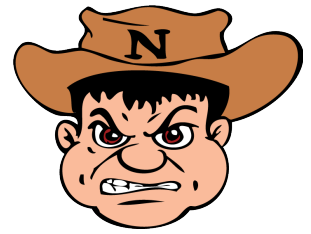

### Northeastern Value

At Northeastern you will receive a top quality education at a fraction of what you may pay at a university. You can get your first 60 credits (halfway to a bachelor's) and an associates at Northeastern and be in an average class size of 22 and have most of your classes taught by full time faculty members. The cost for one year (2011-2012) at NJC includes:

#### Financial Aid

Each year Northeastern administers more than \$5 million in financial aid to students. Starting January 1, complete the FAFSA at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) and make sure you apply for Northeastern scholarships by March 1 to have the opportunity to earn scholarships, grants, loans, and work-study opportunities.

### 10-11 Highlights

- Northeastern is the largest residential two-year school in Colorado with on-campus housing for a total of 602 students
- Northeastern's freshmen retention rate continues to be among the top of its peers.
- During Fall '10 one hundred twenty students received the HOPE and Vision scholarships to help pay up to half of their tuition for their associate's degree.
- Construction is complete and one hundred twenty eight students call the phenomenal Blue Spruce Hall home.
- This academic year marks the start of both men's soccer and women's softball at NJC.
- With help from a forensic anthropologist, students pursuing careers in investigations and law enforcement received hands-on, practical training as they exhumed the buried bodies of two pigs.

- An average class size of 22 ensures you won't get lost in the crowd. Campus has a family-like environment.
- Students attended NJC from all around the world including the countries of Kuwait, Brazil, Canada, South Korea, and Australia.
- Our free tutoring program in our Comprehensive Learning Center (CLC) helped hundreds of students to do their best academically.

### Admission

NJC is an open enrollment institution. Students with a high school diploma or GED can be accepted to complete an associate's degree or certificate program. It is also FREE to apply to NJC. Students can apply online at [www.njc.edu](http://www.njc.edu).
