
2013 Western District BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

- 2. Tournament T-shirts are available for pre-order with a limited number on hand at the venue. Please see attached sheet to pre-order.
- 3. Each team will have a volunteer personal host from the Sterling Lions Club. This person will provide you with any information regarding Sterling and the surrounding area.
- 4. Please park all buses on the west side of Plainsman Park outside of the fenced area.
- 5. Locker rooms are not available at the venue.
- 6. Big Time Small Town Media will be providing live video of every game in the Western District Tournament online at www.ihigh.com/gonjc. Additionally, every game but the opener will be covered on the radio in conjunction with Arnold Broadcasting on 104.7 King FM in Sterling. will be picked up by the microphones. Online ordering of DVD's is available at Big Time Small Town Media.
- 7. Coaches will be provided a hospitality pass that will provide them with a free drink and free sandwich or hotdog each day at the park. The pass can be used at the concession stand in the press box building.
- 8. The District Championship plaque will be distributed following the championship game.
- 9. Media space is limited in the press box. If you have media who that will be making the trip, please contact Marci Henry at marci.henry@njc.edu as soon as possible to arrange for reserved seating. No landline or internet services are available in the press box. Please be sure to provide your own wireless connections.

FIELD TIME:

- 1. Field practice times are assigned below for Wednesday:
 - a. 10:00 am 12:00 pm, Western Nevada
 - b. 12:00 pm 2:00 pm, Cochise
 - c. 2:00 pm 4:00 pm, Northeastern
 - d. Lamar has chosen to practice on their home field.

PREGAME & GAME TIME:

- 1. Northeastern will always occupy the 3rd base dugout. If Northeastern is not playing, the home team will occupy the 3rd base dugout.
- Athletic training services will be provided to all teams. NJC will have our certified ATC trainer on staff throughout the entire tournament. Teams must provide their own supplies for services. All athletes requiring treatment need a written prescription from your trainer or doctor. You may contact our ATC, Nate Kelley with any questions. His number is (970) 521-6674.
- 3. One in and out per day is allowed. Home team will take in and out 30 minutes prior to each game. Visiting team will follow.
- 4. Batting cages will be available for team use prior to each game. No BP will be allowed on the field. Home team will hit 2 hours prior to game time followed by the visiting team. Each team will be allowed 40 minutes.
- 5. Dugout water will be provided.
