This can be fulfilled by submitting a letter or letters of recommendation from teachers, businessmen, former employers, or others who can attest to the applicant's character, work habits, interests, etc.
- 5. Applicant must be willing to actively participate in the NJC Auto Techs Club (i.e.) holding office, serving on committees, promoting the general well being of the Club), during tenure under scholarship.
- 6. Applicant also may be required to attend an interview with the selection committee.

Selection will be made by the NJC Auto Techs Club Scholarship Committee sometime after the application deadline date of March 1 of the current year.
