### **The Bruce & Maxine Gill Memorial Scholarship**

The Bruce Gill Memorial Scholarship is presented to an NJC graduate with a 2.5 GPA or higher, displaying leadership abilities and planning to transfer to Colorado State University. Please indicate any leadership positions or offices held while in high school or college. Attach your proof of acceptance to CSU. This scholarship is to be used for the junior year at CSU. Award amount varies based on availability of funds.

### **The Elsie Good Memorial Scholarship (Separate Application Required)**

The Elsie Good Memorial Scholarship is presented to a Logan County resident with a 3.0 GPA or higher, and will be transferring to a Colorado four-year institution. This scholarship is for \$1,500 per year for two consecutive years. Additional application required for this scholarship. Contact financial aid for application.

### **Tom L. Porter Memorial Scholarship**

The Tom L. Porter Scholarship is a \$500 award to an NJC sophomore transferring to CSU. Student must be from the 5-county region of Northeastern Colorado (Logan, Phillips, Sedgwick, Yuma or Washington County). Attach proof of acceptance to CSU.

### **The Keith Propst Memorial Ag Scholarship**

This \$1,000 scholarship is to be given to an agriculture education graduating sophomore with a 3.5 cumulative GPA, with plans to attend Colorado State University. Attach proof of acceptance to CSU.

### **Johnson and Associates Accounting Scholarship**

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a sophomore student that has completed two years of study in business at NJC. The recipient must have a 3.0 GPA or higher, and must be transferring to a Colorado 4-year college or university to complete a bachelor's degree in Accounting. Student must also be from the 5-county region of northeastern Colorado (Logan, Phillips, Sedgwick, Yuma, or Washington County). Attach proof of acceptance to your chosen transfer institution.

*Several four-year colleges and universities in Colorado and some other states offer scholarships to graduates of community colleges, including Northeastern Junior College, who rank high academically. Graduates interested in these scholarships should consult the director of Financial Aid at the school you are planning to attend.*
