The Bruce Gill Memorial Scholarship (Separate Application Required)

Established in 1994, the Bruce Gill Memorial Scholarship is presented to an NJC graduate displaying scholarship and leadership abilities and planning to transfer to Colorado State University. The award carries a non-renewable \$500 cash stipend to be used for the junior year at CSU. Contact Financial Aid Office for Application.



The Elsie Good Memorial Scholarship (Separate Application Required)

The Elsie Good Memorial Scholarship is presented to a Logan County resident with a 3.0 GPA or higher, and will be transferring to a Colorado four year institution. This scholarship is for \$1500 per year for two years.



The Chadron State College Scholarship

The Chadron State College “Community College Scholarship” is for a current NJC graduate interested in attending Chadron State College located in Chadron, Nebraska. The recipient must have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher. The scholarship is for a full waiver of in-state tuition costs for 12-16 credits per semester. This award is valid for four regular semesters only, commencing with the first semester of the school term in the year of issuance. The one-year renewal of this scholarship will be determined at the end of each semester, based on cumulative CSC GPA, (the minimum for renewal being 3.0).



The Panhellenic Scholarship

This scholarship is to be given to a traditional female student at NJC. She must be a graduating sophomore who is attending a 4-year institution to complete her education. The scholarship will be awarded Fall semester of the student’s junior year. This scholarship will be distributed in four increments: \$500 for three years with all remaining funds given the fourth year.



Tom L. Porter Memorial Scholarship

The Tom L. Porter Scholarship is awarded to any worthy NJC sophomore with acceptance and transferring to CSU.

Several four year colleges and universities in Colorado and some other states offer scholarships to graduates of community colleges, including Northeastern Junior College, who rank high academically. Graduates interested in these scholarships should consult the director of Financial Aid at the school you are planning to attend.
