If a student is classified as an in-state student, but does not apply for or is not eligible for the COF stipend, the student shall be responsible for paying the total in-state tution amount of \$226.30/credit.

Tuition classification is governed by, state law (Colorado Revised Statutes 23-7-1011, et seq., 1998) and by judicial decisions that apply to all public institutions of higher education in Colorado. Northeastern Junior College does not have discretion to make exceptions to the rules as defined by state law.
